CINERARIA

The **Cineraria Multiflora Nana** is for marketing purposes a plant of the highest standing. The blossoms, being of a height of about 1 inch, sumount in large dense umbels umbrella like the delicate foliage underneath. This build of the flower is an advantage, which should not be underestimated because the plant claims during the winter-time considerably less space than plants with a widely spreading growth.

The plant is not affected by putrification of some of its leaves nor by damage done by snails because these leaves are replaced by new shoots without deforming the plant. This Cineraria reaching a height of about 10 inches can be considered the best pot-plant and the most beautiful flower for marketing and decoration purposes.

A crop of the flower may already be secured at Christmas if sown early enough, but its most perfect development and beauty the plant will display during the season of March to May.

THE CULTURE

...OF...

PRIMULA OBCONICA

The PRIMULA OBCONICA must be sowed out between January and May, depending when to expect blooming, either in fall, winter or spring. It must be sowed in old, medium rich soil, mixed with sand. Do not use any leaf mold or Peat, for it contains Tannic acid, which will kill the seedlings. The seed must not be covered. The boxes should be kept dark for 8 to 10 days at a temperature of 60° F during the night. After this the boxes should be removed to a warmer place and be covered with glass plates. Until the germination occurs, which is about 3 weeks after the sowing, the boxes should be kept in a temperature of about 65° F. To obtain a good germination the soil should be kept moist and should be protected against sunlight. The soil should never dry out. **for there might not be any chance to have success in germination.** If the seeds are treated correctly, the germination should be as high as 90 to 95%.

The little seedlings must be replanted after the germination. This time the soil can be somewhat richer.

In the summer the plants can be kept in potts or in beds. As the plants grow bigger the soil can be richer and should contain some clay. Uniform shadow, plenty of air and moist is needed for a good growing of the plants.

Early in the summer growing budstems should be picked out. As they will grow again, it is up to the grower to have the plants blooming any time he likes to.
